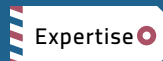

➤ MY ACTIVITIES FOR THE TTTdM

I took part in the activities of the Think Tank Trinità dei Monti as a "Young-thinktanker" in September 2020. I am also coordinating with the Web Manager to update the biography of young think-tankers and I am working with another team for the organization of a webinar.

STUDIES

I am currently attending the International Master in European Studies organized by the Belgian-Italian Chamber of Commerce. In May 2020 I finished my master's degree in European and International Studies at the University of Trento, and in July 2017 I graduated in International Studies at the University of Trieste. I internationalized my study-path with three-abroad experiences: I studied for one year in Waukee High School, Iowa, USA, for six months at the University of Melbourne, Australia, and for six months at the University Paris-1 Pantheon-Sorbonne. In 2019, I also obtained a one-year diploma in Human Security and Sustainable Development at the ISPI School. Finally, in 2018 I took two Summer Schools on Human Rights. The first focused on Children's Rights and was organized by the University of Leiden, Holland; the second focused on migration and was organized by the UNICRI, Rome.

➤ WORK EXPERIENCE

In 2019, I worked as an intern for a Rome-based organization. As a Programme Assistant for the Middle East, I supported the Deputy Regional Director in project-cycle management activities. In 2016, I assisted the Territorial Commission for the Recognition of International Protection of Gorizia, Italy. I carried out administrative tasks, I made researches on asylum seekers' countries of origin, and I drafted the final decrees of the Commission.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

In August 2017, I volunteered for the a NGO providing humanitarian relief in the Kara Tepe Refugee Camp of Lesbos Island, Greece. In August 2014, I volunteered as an elementary school teacher for a NGO operating in Singbury, Thailand.

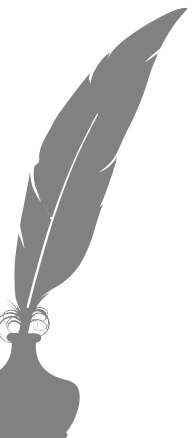
